All are welcome at this mass .

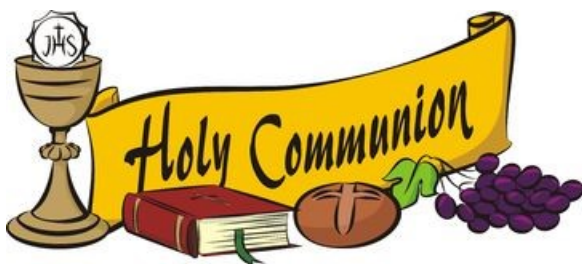
Refreshments will be served in the Parish Hall as well as the children's communion breakfast.
